RESOLUTION ON CONSTITUTING AMERICA - THE RETURN OF FOUNDING PRINCIPLES

WHEREAS, the founding principles of the United States are based upon and drawn from several important historic documents; and

WHEREAS, school children of the United States of America should understand the sacrifice that has been made for their God-given liberty so that a strong Constitutional Republic in the United States may be secured for future generations; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Republican National Committee calls upon the state legislatures in all fifty of the United States to introduce, hold hearings and favorably act on bills supporting the changing and teaching of the history - government sections of the curriculums in grades K - 12 and for the schools of the United States America; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that U.S. schools in grades five through twelve include significant sections on: (1) The Charter of Liberties (1100 A.D.), (2) The Magna Carta, (3) The Mayflower Compact, (4) The Declaration of Independence, (5) The Northwest Ordinance, (6) The United States Constitution, (7) The Federalist Papers and the Anti-Federalist Papers, (8) The U.S. Bill of Rights, (9) The Pledge of Allegiance and the American National Anthem, and (10) The [Great Britain] Bill of Rights of 1689; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that there shall be questions included in the U.S. curriculum testing system to test students on their knowledge of these historic documents to ensure that students are effectively learning these time-honored principles in the aforementioned documents; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, that the Pledge of Allegiance be recited each school day morning, prior to the start of academic instruction, with a United States flag present before them.
